**Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

A five year old child asked his father, "Who is the greatest person in the world?" His father, wanting to build up his son's self esteem, told him that he was. Extremely surprised, his son replied: "But I am just a boy!"

The boy was aware of his own limitations as a child. Many of us, when we were young, imagined ourselves growing up to doing grand things. Whether as a scientist, doctor, astronaut, nurse, pilot, teacher, soldier or other hero, we would imagine ourselves achieving magnificent things, perhaps even curing diseases, saving people from death, or winning awards for our laudable accomplishments. As children we enjoy seeing ourselves great and powerful. However, as the years pass by, many realize that they do not want or are not able to do the things necessary to accomplish such exalted things. We pare down our dreams, set more realistic goals, and become satisfied with the average things of daily life.

This Sunday we are called to have great dreams again, but not in the sense of becoming a hero or attaining great fame - rather - as a disciple of Jesus. When Jesus entered the synagogue and read Isaiah's prophecies, he did so in a way that indicated that they applied to him, saying, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." In other words, Jesus announced that he was the Messiah, the one who would accomplish the great works the people had been hoping for. But his announcement doesn't apply only to himself, we need to realize that as his followers, Jesus' announcement also commits us to doing the same. In our world today, we are Jesus' hands, and feet, and representative in our families, communities and at work. On our own we may not be capable of extraordinary deeds or great wonders, but each time we share of our heart, lives and talent, every time we serve someone or witness to the truth, we accomplish the works that Jesus promised to fulfill.

But that means we have to get involved - or in many cases, get more involved - we need to look for ways to help, to serve, and to share. Our future, and the success we may or may not enjoy, rests solely on how willing we are to go open our hearts to accomplishing God's will. As your pastor, I have great faith in each of you, but more importantly, Our Lord has given you the ability to not just meet, but exceed this challenge. We have a great future ahead of us and without a doubt I know that indeed "this scripture passage will be fulfilled in your hearing."

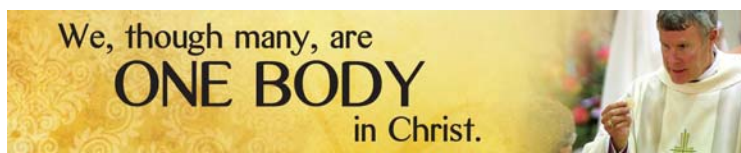

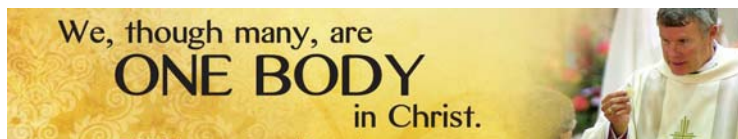
