Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

It's easy to preach about marriage when honoring a couple celebrating many years together. It's also easy to preach about marriage at a wedding, when two people, armed with more hope than experience, offer up pledges of faithfulness. But there are other times --and other listeners-- and sometimes Christ's definitions regarding marriage feel like weapons aimed directly at the wounded. Sometimes, people reeling from the pain and sorrow of their broken lives hear the Church's teachings on marriage and feel attacked or humiliated.

Our society's response to those who are hurting is say: "These teachings are too hard and outdated." It is much more 'pastoral' to simply 'lower the bar' or 'get with the times.' There is no question that holding to what Jesus taught is difficult. Doing so holds up a mirror to our own brokenness --both personal and communal-- and reminds us that we all struggle and need God's mercy.

But we risk much more when we shy away from the Church's teachings on marriage. We lose an essential feature regarding who we are and who we are created to be. Like Holy Orders, marriage is a vocation that leads us to a life of holiness. Like all vocations, it is risky, demanding and incredibly rewarding. It can leave us open to great joy and at the same time, vulnerable to great pain. And for that very reason, as people created in God's image and likeness, we must hold to the truth. We must reach out to those who are suffering without reservation; yet never compromise our commitment to the fullness of our faith.

We must witness to the truth about marriage; not through angry discourse or divisive action, but through our unwavering commitment to Christ's call to love, without reserve and without measure. Our lived witness is a reminder that the covenant of marriage does not lie at the margins of our lives as Catholic Christians, but at its very heart.

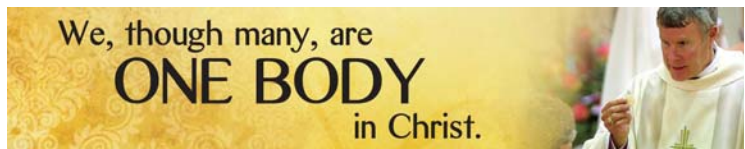

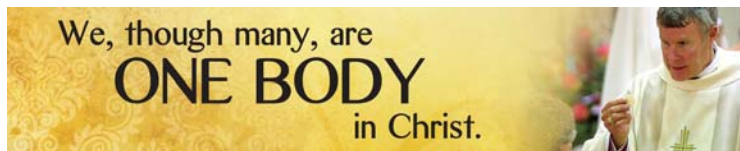
