Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

In our opening gospel, St. Matthew quotes the prophet Zechariah, who foretold the arrival of the Messianic king. Part of Zechariah's prediction was a judgment against the failed line of kings of Judah and Israel whose inadequacies and vanity had brought ruin upon the Jewish people. Zechariah predicts that the "true king" would not come as a dictator robed in power and might, but as a gentle and humble ruler, riding on a donkey. In other words the Messiah would not seem like a king at all, and his coming would be so modest that it would be possible to miss it.

Jesus' entry to Jerusalem, with its joyful abandon, was a parody of the great Roman triumphal processions of the day. Jesus came not in a chariot or on a warhorse, but on a donkey, not fitted with the trappings of majesty and banners of victory, but greeted with the waving of palm branches and piles of dusty cloaks spread on the road. As Holy Week progresses, the contrast between the imperial events of Caesar, the earthly Lord of the World, and Jesus, the Lord of all creation, becomes ever more manifest. At his trial, Jesus is dressed in the parody of the imperial purple clothing. He wears a thorny wreath as a mock crown and is handed a reed as a bogus scepter. Pilate presents him to the crowds for their acclamation and they shout for his death, and in the end Jesus is seated not on a throne but nailed to a cross. Finally, at the foot of the cross, instead of a multitude of followers shouting acclamations of praise, a motley crowd mocks Jesus with insults. The drama of Holy Week is a true parody.

The powerful of our world emphasize their majesty and domination by inflicting punishment and humiliation on those who oppose them, little do they realize that in Jesus' Passion and death the joke is on them. Their earthly pretensions are shown to be vain and empty. Jesus Christ, the Lord of Glory, in his humility, renders impotent the foundations on which all earthly power is founded. At the end of Matthew's crucifixion scene the Centurion declares "truly this man was the Son of God." The Centurion, representative of Caesar, standing beneath the throne of the cross, acclaims the true king whose identity is now clear for all who have eyes to see. By his words, the Centurion acknowledges there is better way to live than what the world aspires to and that there is a greater king than Caesar.


