Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

When the Lord saw her, he was moved with pity and said to her, "Do not weep." Jesus then stepped forward and touched the coffin and said, "Young man, I tell you, arise!"

If I were one of the people present I might have reacted with anger. How could anyone keep from responding in protest: "What are you saying? You're telling a mother and widow, who just lost her son, her ONLY son, do not weep?" How can any mother, on such a day, keep from screaming?

I recall a young man named Joseph, strong and athletic, a hard-worker, a skilled mechanic, a natural leader among his friends and teammates, a young man with a winning smile... tossing his young nephews into the sky in joy and happiness. A brother, a cousin, a son. He was helpful and protective; a friend: energetic, supportive and vivacious. On the day of Joseph's funeral, how could anyone not weep?

What can we as believers do at time like this? What is asked of us? Despite the pain we feel, despite the heaviness that weighs us down, we must muster the courage to turn to God and beg for the help of the Holy Spirit. "Though I walk in the Valley of the Shadow of Death, I fear no evil... for you, Lord, are there... with your rod and your staff that guide me." Where is our hope in the Valley of darkness?

To help us trust in the words of the Lord, I'd like to you to remember some words from Joseph as well. One day, Joseph walked into his grandmother's kitchen with his arm scuffed, skinned and scabbed over from football practice. She asked him: "Why do you this to yourself, Joseph? Why does it have to be so rough? Why must you play so hard?" He said, "Grandma, sometimes, you have to play through the pain."

I think that on some level, we all find ourselves doing exacting that: playing through the pain... Like athletes, there are days when the challenges make our hearts pound, our bodies ache... but, together, we push forward, straining as we hear the Lord say to us: "Arise! Arise from the darkness!"

The darkness of grief. The darkness of sin. The darkness of fear. The darkness of pain and loss and hopelessness. This is what we do, it is all we can do - we play through the pain - but we do not play through the pain alone.

When the Lord saw her, he was moved with pity and said to her, "Do not weep." He then stepped forward and touched the coffin. No matter what darkness might overcome us, the Lord enters into our darkness and touches the coffin... he touches the wood... he receives the nails... he cries out in despair. He. Enters. Our. Darkness.

And somehow, somehow, he helps us into the Light... the Light of a New Life, free of all that is rough and hurtful.

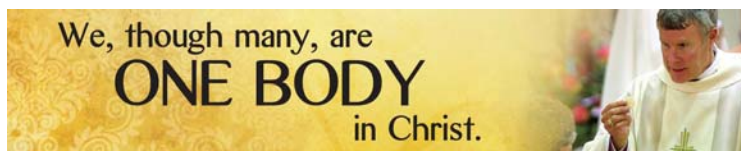
