Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

St. Luke reveals two things about the woman in this week's Gospel. 1) That she was "a sinful woman" and 2) that she loved Jesus a lot. Clearly she understood the implications of Jesus' preaching regarding God's love and mercy because uninvited; she entered the Pharisee's home with a costly flask of ointment. She stood behind Jesus and bathed his feet with her tears and wiped his feet with her hair, kissing His feet and anointing them.

The Pharisee said under his breath, "If this man were a prophet, he would know who and what sort of woman this is who is touching him, that she is a sinner." The fact is that Jesus did know who she was and what she'd done. But she was sorry, so whatever sins she had committed were no longer important to Him. What was important was her repentance and her gratitude to Him as evidenced by the love she was showing.

Jesus then turned to the Pharisee and somewhat rebuked him for not showing Him any love, reminding him that when Jesus entered his house the Pharisee had not provided Him with any water to wash His feet, did not greet Him with a with kiss, nor did he offer to anoint His head with oil. In comparison, the woman, who the Pharisee was condemning in his thoughts, had bathed Jesus' feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. Even more, she ceaselessly kissed His feet and has anointed them with ointment. "So I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven because she has shown such great love."

Jesus tells us that her many sins have been forgiven because she showed such great love. But He also points out that "But the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little."

Have you ever helped someone only to be irked by their lack of gratitude or sense of entitlement? I have. But God is not that way. We are in the midst of celebrating the "Year of Mercy", and the centerpiece of Divine Mercy is that God loves us even though we don't deserve it. Our response, like the woman in our gospel, should be our own gratefulness to God and desire to share with others the love and mercy we have received.

To be fully Catholic means that we have a compassionate heart – God asks us to show compassion towards others without judging or condemning them. We are to focus on the needs of others and attend to those around us who are weak, disadvantaged and marginalized.

To be fully Catholic means that we have a soul full of gratitude – We are invited to recount and be grateful for all the blessings we have received. Albert Einstein once said, "There are only two ways to live your life. One is as if nothing is a miracle. The other is as if everything is." For no reason other than he loves us, God has been merciful to us, and we are called to share that mercy with others.

To be fully Catholic means that we have curious minds – We are challenged to be life-long learners – to contemplate the mysteries of eternity, of life, and the marvel of God's creation. We are asked to seek God's will in our life and to follow where he leads us.

To be fully Catholic means that we are to be strong and energetic – Our achievements are directly related to the efforts we put forth. As Catholics we are called to utilize our time, talent and treasures, witnessing to others of the love God has shown to us.

God is always there for us – to help us – to forgive us and to strengthen us. The measure that we respond to God's love is the measure to which we realize how truly blessed we are. Amen.

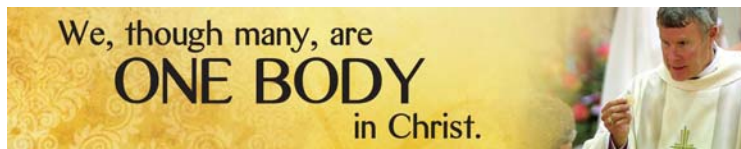

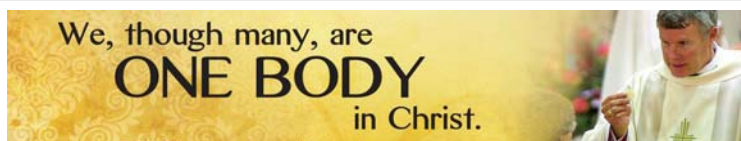
