Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sometimes people seem dominated by a level of melancholy and depression. Today, more than ever, people seem to think that “anything in the past was better.” We anticipate a future that is more contaminated, problematic, and has more tensions than in the past. Quarrels over climate change, the scarcity of essential resources, population shifts, and cultural clashes lead to armed conflict and are problems that capture media attention. This focus by the media on our problems triggers in us, in many ways, a pessimistic attitude. How can anyone possibly be happy in a world such as ours? If that wasn’t enough, our personal problems are always present. Is there anyone free from problems in their family? Who doesn’t feel the dangers of illnesses and death, tragedy and misfortune, sorrow, strife and stress?

In contrast with this reality, which at times can be overwhelming, this week’s gospel speaks of the joy that comes about by being bearers (or receivers) of the Good News of salvation. We don’t have to regard the changes in our world as having made it a much worse place than during the time of Jesus. Perhaps the world was less polluted then, but other problems were very serious at that time. Poverty, sickness and little or no health care, for example, were pressing problems for the majority of the people in Jesus’ day. Taxation and military oppression were ever present, and educational and occupational opportunities were virtually non-existent. That was the context into which Jesus sent out 72 disciples, two-by-two, to preach the Good News, to wish everyone peace, to bring hope to the sick and needy, and to announce that the kingdom of God was near. It was a simple message and a source of joy for those who transmitted it and those who received it.

Today we are the recipients of that message. Beyond the disasters (natural and man-made), we experience and other changes in our world, God continues to offer us life, hope and peace. “The Kingdom of God is near”. As we read in the Gospel, it is within us to accept the peace that comes from God or reject it; but even in the case where it is rejected, we must be aware that the kingdom of God is coming.

We are also transmitters of the message. It is the treasure that God has placed in our hands. It is why we glorify in Jesus and make him the center of our life; and, by both our words and actions, why we announce peace and trust that God is capable of recreating, no matter what is or has gone wrong in our world.

I pray each and every one of you have a happy and safe 4th of July.
