**17 July 2016**

**Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

This week we have two sisters - Martha and Mary. They represent two different approaches to Jesus. You could say a lot about each of them, but I would express the difference this way: Martha wanted Jesus to listen to her, while Mary wanted to listen to Jesus.

When I have discussed this Gospel with groups of people, almost everyone (including me) identifies with Martha. We have work to do, problems on our mind, things that need to be finished before we can relax. When we try to pray, our minds spin with a dozen distractions. We remember a phone call we should make, something we need to get at the store, a task that just can't wait, etc. And - God forgives us for our inability to properly focus on him just like he forgave Martha.

But that's not my point. Deep down, we know that the best present we've ever received was not a gift, cash or a delicious meal. While those things are wonderful, we desire something else. If we were to think about it, we would recognize that the best gift someone ever gave us was this: they gave us their full and undivided attention. They took the time to listen to us and acknowledge what we cared about. That is the gift Mary gave to Jesus. Martha was busy doing something for Jesus - and, to accomplish it, she wanted Jesus to listen to her. Mary on the other hand, just wanted to listen to Jesus. "Mary," said Jesus, "has chosen the better part."

How do people become friends or fall in love? By spending time together, sharing their hopes and desires, supporting each other's dreams, encouraging each other in their struggles and lifting each other up when they're tired. But if we don't listen to each other, give our attention to and take the time to support each other, then our bonds of friendship and affection will dry up and we will end up drifting apart.

In our family relationships (brother to sister, spouse to spouse, parent to child, etc.) we easily recognize the power of open-ended, undistracted listening. The same thing applies to prayer. Jesus has all the time in the world to listen to you and me. He comes from the point of view of eternity, which by definition is undivided and perfectly open-ended. The problem is not that Jesus doesn't listen to us, but that we are reluctant to do what Mary did - to put aside all else and listen to him.

We can all identify with Martha's desire to get things done (and speaking for myself, I would appreciate the meal she prepared). Still, she has a fault that we can equally identify with - her anxiety to have others (including Jesus), listen to her. Mary, on the other hand, simply listens to Jesus. "Mary has chosen the better
