**24 July 2016**

**Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

“Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name.” How many times have you said this prayer? For most of us, it is the first prayer we learned. Today we see where it comes from. And in a bit of irony, this formal prayer that almost everyone knows seems to come from Jesus telling the disciples not to rely on formal prayers, but to pray simply, familiarly, and from the heart.

When he is asked about prayer, Jesus instructs us to call God our father, to speak to him like family, because he is our father in heaven, and like our father on earth, He wants to help and protect us. I call my father “Dad.” Jesus is encouraging us to have a relationship with God the Father that is so close that we can say, “Dad, how are things in heaven?” And we should respect God the Father, like we respect our earthly Mom and Dad. His name is holy, and when we use it in derogatory or disrespectful ways, we commit a serious sin.

Just like we asked our parents for help and advice as we grew up, so should we call on God the Father for what we need. What father would give a snake to a child asking for food? None. Nor would our heavenly Father. If an earthly father cares for and supports his family, how much more will our heavenly Father?

Our earthly parents don’t abandon us if we do something wrong, nor will our heavenly Father. God loves us and wants us to learn and choose what is right from wrong and to protect us from danger, like any good parent. Unlike God the Father, no earthly parent is perfect. Parents, like everyone else, sin, even when they try not to, and do their best to set a good example. And if we imperfect people can still manage to be good parents to our children, how much better is our perfect heavenly Father? So that makes God the Father our role model. Like our earthly Dad, He loves and forgives us, and in turn He calls on us to love and forgive each other. We should help our friends in need like our Father provides for us.

The prayer “Our Father” has become standardized and formal. We say it every day - and if you don’t, I’d strongly encourage you to form the habit of doing so. That being said, when we pray the Our Father, we should make an effort to think about what its words mean and what we are saying. We are acknowledging that we love and respect him. We are asking for our basic needs, asking for guidance in knowing and living out His will for us, asking for his forgiveness when necessary, and promising to love and care for each other like he loves and cares for us.
