**Second Sunday of Lent**

Why are the numbers of Catholics who practice their faith declining, and why doesn't being Christian constitute a major point of reference for most people anymore? Why the boredom, the weariness, the struggle for people who believe to get involved in parish and service activities? Why do young people not feel attracted to the faith? In sum, why the dullness and lack of joy among Catholic Christians? Jesus' transfiguration addresses those questions.

What did the transfiguration mean for the apostles who were present? Until then they only knew Jesus by his external manifestations. His miracles, messages and outward appearance were not significantly different from other great prophets, and they knew his family, where he was from, his habits, his mannerisms, and so on. With the Transfiguration they know Jesus in another way, a deeper way -- a way that cannot be measured by worldly standards.

Such a thing can happen to us too; as exemplified when young people fall in love. When we fall in love, our beloved, who was before merely one of many, or perhaps even unknown, suddenly becomes the only one, the sole person in the world who holds our attention. All our other relationships become secondary. In a very real sense, when one falls in love a transfiguration takes place.

Falling in love also changes in our actions and attitudes. I have known young people whose parents could not get them out of bed in the morning. Then, once they fell in love, they jumped out of bed, impatient to get going with their day. What happened? Everything was now seen in a different light. What they were compelled to do before, they now did willingly because of the new sense of purpose love had given them. Love allows us to do willingly things that force could not make us do before.

I believe that the same thing needs to happen in our faith lives for us to become true, committed Catholics. When I told my fishing buddies that I was not going to join them for our annual trip because I was going to become a priest, they told me that I was crazy! What they couldn't understand was that once we've been touched by God's love, our priorities change. His presence and love for us is real, and we need to respond to that love in fuller ways than we have in the past.

In human love we can deceive ourselves, attributing to our beloved gifts that they do not have and over time our "view" of them becomes "tarnished" and their flaws apparent. Conversely, with Jesus the more we know and spend time with him, the more we discover new reasons to be in love with him.

This does not mean that we must wait for the classic "lightning bolt" of love to strike us. If a young man or woman stayed at home without ever going out to meet others, nothing would happen in their lives. To fall in love you have to spend time with someone!

If you are not in love with Jesus, it's not because Jesus is not in love with you. So what can we do to experience the joy of God's love? Spend time with him in prayer and read the New Testament writings - the Gospels are his love letters to you! It is there that He reveals himself and "transfigures" himself to you. Additionally, we have the books "Rediscovering Jesus" and "Resisting Happiness" which have great, practical insights on how to go about encountering and falling in love with our Lord. Lastly, his house is our Church --and his Presence is found in the Eucharist-- consider making a habit of coming to Church beyond when you attend Mass to pray before the reserved Blessed Sacrament. I promise you, if you reach out to Our Lord, he will both reveal himself to you and change your life, not just for the better, but for the amazing!

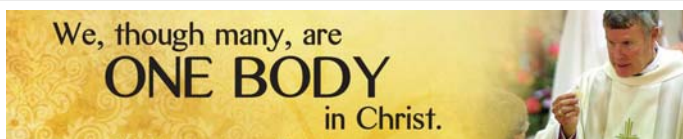
