The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

It is rare where we have meetings, gatherings or other important social occasions and food and beverages are not also provided. Some of my most cherished family memories include the foods and beverages served at our gatherings. Whether at work, in public or at home, eating and drinking is something we all do regardless of the differences among ourselves. When we share a meal, it seems that disagreements diminish and we find a common ground where we can all be family and friends.

Throughout the Gospels Jesus is frequently seen eating and drinking: with his disciples, at his friends' homes, in the field multiplying loaves and fishes, immediately after his resurrection, etc. Also, Jesus often speaks of the kingdom of God in terms of a great banquet or wedding feast. In the weeks following His resurrection, Jesus prepared breakfast on the shore while Peter and the disciples were fishing. The image of a meal, so familiar for everyone regardless of nationality or culture, is something we can all understand and appreciate. It threatens no one and invites all.

On the other hand, it is often said that "we are what we eat." Which is, in a certain way, a scientific explanation of food, but Jesus expands that understanding to make personal His gift of self in the Eucharist. That is why Jesus connects His Last Supper with His death on the Cross. Laying down one's life is the most perfect and complete self-surrender; and connecting His sacrifice with the Pascal "Lamb of God", and the Manna in the desert with the "Bread of Life", the Eucharist; Jesus gives us his body and blood so that we can become what we eat; and thus, we become the body and blood of Jesus in spirit and in truth.

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, that is the Body (and Blood) of Christ. If we are what we eat, then we too connect His sacrifice (to save us from our sins) with the Holy Communion we receive, where, like Him --out of love-- we realize that it is our destiny to give of ourselves to others. It is not easy to give everything: body and soul; to do so requires total self-denial, an extraordinary ability to love, and to drive to pay attention to the needs of others. It requires from us a passionate willingness to go wherever necessary and to do whatever is necessary. It is neither easy nor comfortable; but it is the only thing that will bring us true joy and fulfillment, because it feeds us and feeds the others. We may not be able to do it on our own, but we can do it because Christ is in us, if we open ourselves and give ourselves first to Him. Amen.

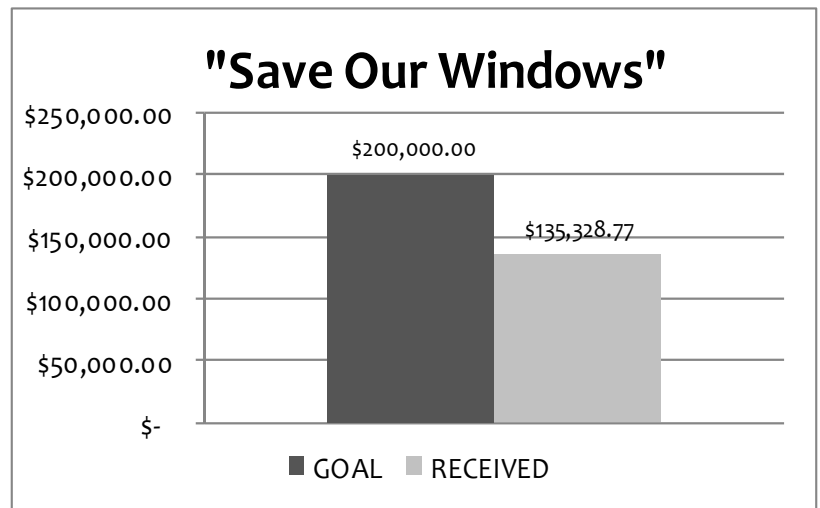
