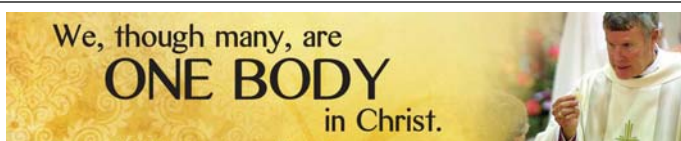

## KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

Prospective Knight,

Hi! My name is Butch Grell, and I am Grand Knight of the Immaculate Conception Council of the Knights of Columbus.

We are currently conducting a membership drive and we are hoping to interest you in joining our honored Order of the Knights of Columbus ("K of C"). If you are a Catholic man, age 18 or more, in good standing, you are qualified to be a contributing member of this impressive Catholic fraternal organization. The K of C is the manpower source of our Parish and is the largest order of Catholic men in the world.

The K of C was founded in 1882 in New Haven, Connecticut by Father Michael J. McGivney when he and the men of his parish met to form an organization with two main goals: 1) to provide support for widows and their children; and 2) to serve churches, schools, communities, families and youth.

Locally, our Father O'Reilly Council meets these goals in some of the following ways: providing funding for special needs organizations; annual support of a seminarian; "Coats for Kids" (helping needy children of the Lawton and Merville school districts stay warm); Mary's Choice (a pro-life group) and annual post-secondary scholarships to children of K of C members, to name just a sample of K of C good works.

The Fr. O'Reilly Council of the K of C raises these funds through its annual fish fries, biweekly breakfasts after Mass, and special events like the Tootsie Roll Drive.

The Council meets on the second Tuesday of the month. Currently we have approximately 60 active members with a number of these experiencing advanced age and becoming less able to be as active as in the past. This means we have a need for younger, more able-bodied members to carry on the good work of the Father O'Reilly Council. Many Knights members find this to be a meaningful way of giving back to God for his blessings bestowed on them and their families.

In the next week or so I will be contacting you by phone to answer any questions you may have and to find out if you are interested in joining the Fr. O'Reilly Council of the Knights of Columbus.

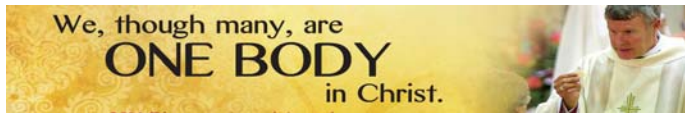

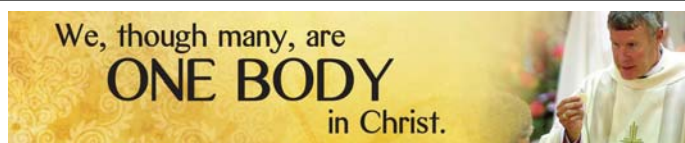
